Ripponden Community Market Sunday 22nd March 2015

Ripponden Community Market, winner of NABMA's Best Local Council Market 2014, returns to the village on Sunday 22nd March. The market will be at its usual site on the car park at Brig Royd Surgery, Halifax Road and will be open to shoppers from 9.30am.

The market is organised and run by Ripponden Parish Council and Chairman, Cllr Steve McCarley said "Shoppers will be able to buy some of the best, locally produced food and crafts".

Stalls will be selling handcrafted gifts, cards, jewellery, driftwood sculptures, artwork, wooden novelties and accessories for the home. Visitors will have the opportunity to buy fresh flowers and locally produced artisan foods including pork pies, cakes, farmhouse cheeses, and speciality biscuits.

New for this market will be the sale of venison. Shoppers at the market will also be able to enjoy freshly cooked venison burgers and sausages on the day.
