If so, Ripponden Parish Council wants to know.

The Parish Council is asking for entries for its annual Good Citizen Award – to publically thank someone who has made a positive difference to the lives of others in Ripponden, Rishworth, Barkisland or Soyland.

All residents over the age of 18 are eligible to be nominated if you think they have made an outstanding contribution to the Ripponden Parish area. Entry forms are available from the Parish council office in Ripponden, via email and can also be downloaded from its website, and must be submitted before 30 November 2015 to the Clerk of the Parish Council.

Judging will be decided by a Parish Council Panel, and the Award presented by its Chairman at the Annual Civic Dinner held in March. All nominees will receive a Citizen of the Year Award certificate, whilst the winner will receive a trophy and have their name entered on the Roll of Winners in the Parish Council office, as did Mrs Diane Hall last year.

The winner will also be put forward for the Calderdale Citizen Celebration Award, which is organised annually by Calderdale Metropolitan Borough Council.
